DRAFT Terms of Reference

Purpose

To provide a forum for the Brecon Beacons National Park Authority (BBNPA) to meet and engage with the Mynydd Du graziers and their representative organisations to consider and recommend commons management in pursuit of the National Park purposes and duty.

Composition 2018/19

One/two BBNPA members from Carmarthenshire County Council, the Landscape and Biodiversity Champion, Welsh Language Champion, Natural Resources Manager, Wardens Manager, Warden(s) covering Mynydd Du, a representative from Natural Resources Wales, and chairs and secretaries of the representative associations.

Meetings

Meithrin Mynydd Advisory Group (MMAG) meetings will be held in May and November each year until further notice. The BBNPA will nominate a Member chair who will be required to:

- circulate the agenda and relevant supporting information 5 working days in advance;
- record minutes and actions during the meeting and circulate within 10 working days.

Related Groups

MMAG is an advisory group and relates to the BBNPA governance and management arrangements.

General Terms of Reference

1. To provide opportunity for short term operational commons management issues to be addressed;
2. To develop and maintain under review an integrated management plan, as resources allow, which will set out the objectives, options and desired outcomes for future management activities;
3. To robustly scrutinise the outcomes delivered through commons management activities and partnership work, review lessons learned and set clear future priorities aligned to cost-effective delivery of the conservation objectives of Mynydd Du Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI), historic and cultural landscapes, Scheduled Ancient Monuments, and the National Park Management Plan.
